GET YOUR SET READY FOR 2019

Let the pro shop get your golf gear ready to go for 2019! Schedule a fitting for a new Driver, FW, irons, wedges or putter. If your set is good to go for the new year allow us to put fresh grips on the set for 2019.

2019 USGA RULE CHANGES

As many already know the USGA has implemented some rules changes for 2019 going forward. Here is a summary of some of the major changes

1. Dropping Procedure

Last year it was proposed that golfers could drop from any height above an inch, however this has been changed to knee height. So from 1st Jan 2019, when taking relief golfers will now drop from knee height - no longer shoulder height.

2. Moving the ball

There will be no penalty for accidentally moving your ball on the putting green or when looking for it in the rough. A player is not responsible for causing a ball to move unless it is "virtually certain" that they did.

3. Relaxed putting green rules

There will be no penalty if a ball played from the putting green hits an unattended flagstick in the hole; players may putt without having the flagstick attended or removed. Players may repair spike marks and other damage made by shoes, animal damage and other damage on the putting green and there is no penalty for merely touching the line of putt.

4. Relaxed bunker rules

There will be no penalty for moving loose impediments in a bunker or for generally touching the sand with a hand or club. A limited set of restrictions (such as not grounding the club right next to the ball) is kept to preserve the challenge of playing from the sand; however, an extra relief option is added for an unplayable ball in a bunker, allowing the ball to be played from outside the bunker with a two-stroke penalty.
