Dress Code

Golf Dress Code

Male Golfers must be properly attired in collared golf shirts with sleeves, golf slacks or golf shorts of a kind normally sold in the golf shop and “soft-spike” golf shoes or tennis shoes. Hats must be worn forward and shirts must be tucked in at all times (unless the entire front length of the shirt is button down and designed to be worn untucked). Jeans, denim of any kind cargo pants (defined as shorts or pants with expandable side pockets), bathing suits, cut-off shorts, sweat pants, T-Shirts, tank tops and bare feet are NOT permitted. All clothing must be in good repair.

Female Golfers must be properly attired in golf shirts, pants (Capri or otherwise) and shorts, skirts and skirts of a kind normally sold in the golf shop and “soft spike golf shoes or tennis shoes. Jeans, denim of any kind, cargo pants (defined as shorts or pants with expandable side pockets), bathing suits, cut-off shorts, sweat pants or leggings (unless worn under shorts, skirts or skirts), T-Shirts, tube tops, halter tops, bare midriffs or extreme cutaway tops are NOT permitted. All clothing must be in good repair.

Tennis Dress Code

Male Tennis Players must be properly attired in collared tennis shirts or mock-collared tennis shirts, shorts and properly soled non-marking tennis shoes. Cotton T-Shirts with a tennis message on it are acceptable for junior players only (17 and under). Cut-off jeans, bathing suits, gym shorts, tank tops, cotton t-shirts, and similar clothing is NOT acceptable.

Female Tennis Players shall be properly attired in tennis dresses, tennis appropriate shirts or tank tops and tennis shorts, and properly soled non-marking tennis shoes. Cut-off jeans, bathing suits, gym shorts, outfits with midriff showing, and similar clothing is NOT acceptable.

Aquatics Dress Code

All swimmers must wear bona fide swimming attire while in the pool. Brazilian style bathing attire, thongs and swimwear not worn as designed are not permitted anywhere in the pool area. In addition, cut-offs, Bermuda shorts and other clothing shorts are not permitted swimwear. All diaper age children must wear swim diapers at all times while in the pools.

Spa and Sports Club Dress Code

Appropriate workout attire must be worn at all times, including shirts and shoes. Denim of any kind, bare midriffs, ripped shirts, swimwear and similar clothing are NOT acceptable. Dress denim (see definition below) may be worn in the Michael Chang Lounge.

Clubhouse/Dining Dress Code

Members and their guests (ages 4 and up) are expected to wear appropriate attire when on Club property. Shoes must be worn at all times. Swimwear of any kind, workout clothes, t-shirts of any kind, color or cost (other than approved tennis wear and dress t-shirts with no message or advertising), hooded sweatshirts, sweat pants, body suits (i.e. spandex, etc.), bicycle shorts, short shorts, tank tops, tube tops, bare midriff, or other extreme cut away tops, worn or tattered clothing, and visible undergarments are NOT permitted at any time in the main clubhouse.

The Preserve

Golf attire shall be considered the minimum acceptable dress for The Preserve during dinner hours. Golf or tennis attire shall be considered the minimum acceptable dress for The Preserve during lunch or breakfast hours. Hats, caps or visors may not be worn in The Preserve at any time. Dress Denim (see below) slacks and Capri pants (but no other type of Dress Denim) are permitted in The Preserve.

The Craftsman and Patio

Golf or tennis attire (including dress t-shirts with no message or advertising) shall be considered the minimum acceptable attire in The Craftsman and patio at all times. "Dress Denim" is permitted in the clubhouse, The Craftsman and patio and is proper fitting denim designed to be worn as slacks, capri pants, skirts or jackets and must be in good repair with no holes rips, tears, tatters or frays, no acid washing, and no hand-written messages or pictures. Denim of any other kind including, but not limited to, shorts, skorts, shirts or blouses are NOT permitted. Dress denim is not permitted at special member events unless specifically designated as being permitted.

Special Occasions

Certain club events may require a more formal dress such as "Jackets Required" or "Black Tie Optional", etc. Please refer to the Club calendar and promotional flyers for the dress code for such events.
