

All Members and guests are expected to be neat, well-groomed and wearing clothing appropriate for the activity in which they are participating. Maintaining an environment appropriate for a country club is part of our tradition at Porter Valley. Members and guests should use common sense and err on the side of propriety when considering dress options. We reserve the right to deny access to anyone improperly dressed and appreciate your cooperation.

#### Clubhouse, Grounds and Communal Areas (Country Club Casual)

Business and casual attire in good taste

Fitness, tennis, or golf specific clothing is acceptable

Footwear must be worn at all times, bare or stocking feet are not acceptable

Denim jeans and skirts in good repair are acceptable

Cutoff, frayed, torn, soiled, see-through or revealing clothing is not acceptable

All hats, visors, and caps must be worn with the bill to the front

Changing of clothes or shoes in the parking lot is not acceptable

#### Dining

##### ***Permitted:***

Business and casual attire in good taste

Tennis or golf specific clothing is acceptable

Denim jeans and skirts in good repair

Footwear is required; clean golf shoes and sandals are acceptable

Hats and visors must be removed (men) when seated in the grill room or grill lounge

##### ***Not Permitted:***

Swimwear

Shirts or clothing with insolent/impudent graphics or ads

Cutoff, frayed, torn, soiled, see through or revealing clothing

Tank tops (men and women) or sleeveless shirts (men)

Athletic specific attire without a cover-up

#### Golf Course and Practice Areas

Golf specific approved footwear with soft spikes and non-aggressive tread.

##### ***Permitted:***

Golf shirts must have a collar or mock collar

Women may wear golf specific shirts with sleeves either with or without a collar

Women wearing golf specific shirts with no sleeves must have a collar

Golf shirts must be tucked in unless designed to be worn untucked

Slacks and shorts in good repair

For women, culottes and capris in good repair

Golf shorts, skirts and dresses should reach at least mid-thigh as measured while standing

All hats, visors and caps must be worn with the bill to the front

##### ***Not Permitted:***

Denim regardless of color

Short shorts, cutoff shorts or pants

Baggy, unkempt or low hanging pants or shorts

Non-golf athletic shorts, pants, skirts, or tights

Tank tops, halter-tops, crop tops, bare midriff or low cut shirts

Cargo shorts or pants

#### **Tennis Facilities:**

##### ***Permitted:***

Clubhouse dress code applies to the patio

Tennis specific attire is required while using courts

Non-marking tennis shoes only

##### ***Not Permitted:***

Cotton or non-tennis graphic tee shirts

Running or black soled shoes

Clothing not approved by tennis circuit  
Non-tennis tank tops, halter-tops, crop tops, sport bras or low cut shirts  
Cutoff shorts or pants  
Denim regardless of color

**Fitness Center:**

***Permitted:***

Athletic specific clothing is required  
Sneakers or footwear designed for athletic use  
Tank tops and sleeveless athletic shirts  
Certain Club hosted activities may require alternative footwear  
Warm-ups and/or cover-ups should be worn when entering or leaving the fitness center

***Not Permitted:***

Non-athletic sandals with open back or flip flops  
Footwear that may cause personal injury or damage to equipment/facility  
Revealing, see through or low cut clothing  
Swimwear or street clothes  
Denim regardless of color  
Cutoffs or undershirts

**Swimming Pool and Deck:**

***Permitted:***

Clubhouse dress code applies with rubber soled footwear only on pool deck  
Appropriate swimwear is required when using the pool  
Cover ups and footwear must be worn when leaving the aquatics area  
Children who are not "potty-trained" must wear swim diapers and/or waterproof diaper cover

***Not permitted:***

Cut off clothing or thong type swimwear  
Hairpins or hair clips without a swim cap
